
### Finding your way

During the renovation, the beach tents will be closer to the sea on a temporary promenade for two summers. Two pedestrian bridges over the construction site will connect the promenade to the beach. The beach will remain accessible to everyone via access ramps around the outer edges of the construction site.





For more than 200 years, Scheveningen has been The Hague's unique seaside resort. Now, Municipality of The Hague and Heijmans are working outside to ensure its future as a special place by the sea. Renovation work will be carried out on the promenade between De Pier, Kurhaus and Museum Beelden aan Zee until the summer of 2025. We are building an extraordinary promenade. In the meanwhile, you can feel free to visit your favourite spot. You can stroll along the promenade from north to south, and the beach bars will also be open and accessible (from March to October) throughout the season. Inside or outside, the beach always remains close by.

# An extraordinary promenade

The new promenade will be on average 10 metres wider and much greener. In front of the Kurhaus will be a central square with special lighting, inspired by light posts from the past. A impressive 30-metre staircase and access ramps will connect the promenade and the beach, making it accessible to all. The location of the beach tents will be moved after 2026 to offer a better view of the sea. The new design will also feature smart solutions for rainwater, electricity and internet and a new site for the Leger & Vloot monument.

#### Working hours

Renovation work will be completed in summer 2025. Work will be carried out in six main phases. Work will be carried out Monday through Friday during working hours (approximately from 7 am to 4 pm). This means that, come the weekend, you will be free to enjoy the mewing of the seagulls and rustling of the wind on the beach.

#### Lively seaside resort

Scheveningen is one of The Hague's seaside resorts. During the renovation, the promenade will remain an extraordinary place. In cooperation with the Buitengewoon Scheveningen Foundation, the municipality will organise a lively programme around the promenade throughout the year. Enjoy the diversity of Scheveningen.
